

WHAT IS LOVE?

1 Corinthians 13:1-7 -- Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.

Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;

Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

1 Corinthians 13:8-12 - Charity never faileth:

but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.

For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.

But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.


And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.


Per the Bible,

WHAT IS LOVE?

Today we know from 1 John 4:8 & 1 Corinthians 13:8-12,

GOD, who is LOVE, NEVER FAILS!

This means,

God will never fail us.

Example: Like many, a woman I know truly strives to serve God to be acceptable in His sight. But, knowing God's standard is perfection (In Christ) she seeks to ensure she does good works and because she believes it correct to do so. But, always in back of her mind she understands she doesn't measure up to God's perfect standard. Yet, she continues striving to have a good attitude and good works vaugely hoping and wondering, like a dice roll, if she'll be acceptable to God. Some days it's, "Yes.", other days it's, "Maybe", and other days it's, "No" – sometimes all in one day!

Here we see the world's standard and definition of Love is not God's definition of Love. Here we see how we've all failed in perfect love and have been failed in perfect love. Yet, our standard is perfect love – from others. Here we see how by definition, people are mislead on the true meaning of love – which is a commitment and selfless choice to not fail. It is not what the world calls "unconditional love" which does not exist in the Bible or humankind.

Here we see how to model the true definition of Love into our lives and towards others, let our Love towards God and neighbors be, "Never failing..."

WHAT IS LOVE?

1 Corinthians 13:8-12 – **Charity never faileth**:

Love is: Long suffering

Love is: Kind

Love does not: Envy

Love is not: Arrogant

Love is not: Proud

Love is not: Out of Order

Love is not: Selfish

Love is not easily: Angered

Love does not think: Evil (Suspicious, Accusatory, Negative)

Love does not: Delight in Sin

Love rejoices in: Truth

Love: Bears all things (Carries)

Love: Believes all things (Faith)

Love: Hopes all things Love: Endures all things.

Love: **Never Fails**

Today we know from 1 John 4:8 & 1 Corinthians 13:8-12,

GOD, who is LOVE, NEVER FAILS!

This means,

God will never fail us!

Let's not fail God.

Let's practice these traits of Love towards God and neighbors (everyone)!
